4. Who would you call the antagonist of this book? Is there just one? Would you call Constance and her friends the "good guys"? Justify your reasoning.

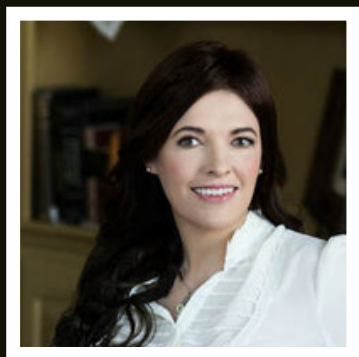
5. Trusdale continues to lie to Constance and keep secrets throughout this book. Should he have acted differently, or was he in a position where he had no other choice?

ABOUT THE AUTHOR




